



Parts and function



Warning signs



Do not exceed the maximum capacity of sheets per pass



Read and learn the warnings written in this document



Avoid touching the document feed opening with hands



Avoid hair touching the document feed opening



Product is not intended for use by children (product is not a toy)



Avoid clothing touching the document feed opening



Keep aerosol products away



Do not shred paper clips



Keep body parts away from moving parts



- Avoid touching exposed blades under Micro-cut shredder head.
 The grounded socket outlet should be installed near the equipment and be easily accessible.

Continuous forms, adhesive labels, transparencies, newspaper, paper clips, cardboard, wet paper, laminates or plastics other than noted above

Maintenance



Lubricate when or immediately, if:

- Capacity decreases
- The motor sounds different, or shredder stops running







Apply oil across entry.



Press "Fwd".







Set to "Rev" for 2-3 seconds.






Only use a non-aerosol vegetable oil in long nozzle container



For paper:




Please check the voltage of your shredder carefully before using and then plug in the cable, set the switch to "I" position.





Press "Power ON/OFF", the Power LED lamp should be turned on green and indicate standby mode.

For credit cards/CD:




Please check the voltage of your shredder carefully before using and then plug in the cable, set the switch to "I" position.




Press "Power ON/OFF", the power LED lamp should be turned on green and indicate standby mode.





Feed the paper into the entry and release. The machine will start the shredding process automatically.




If you want to stop the shredding process, press the "Rev" button for 2-3 seconds.

The machine will reverse and eject the papers.



Feed the credit cards/ CD into the marked entry and the machine will start the shredding process automatically.




Set switch to "O" and unplug the cable after use.




Troubleshooting

1. Paper jam

Symptom: Indicator light

Solution:





2. Bin open

Symptom: ## red light indicates door open.

Solution: Check the bin and make sure it's closed correctly.



3. Bin full

Symptom: red light indicates bin full.

Solution: Take out the bin and empty it. Put the bin in place until the :: light goes out.





Continuous operation beyond 10-15 minutes may trigger cool down period for over 30 minutes due to overheat. Turn off the unit after use.

Recycling
